BIOGRAPHY OF A DOCTOR

Dr Yap Foo Ngan

Portrait of a Malaysian Anaesthetist: T. Sachithanandan — Pioneer, Leader, Gentleman, published in September 2022, is penned by his son Dr Anand Sachithanandan, a cardiothoracic surgeon.

(Retails at RM100. Proceeds will be donated to the Malaysian Society of Intensive Care and Lung Cancer Network Malaysia.)


In 1981, Malaysian medical (in particular anaesthetic) profession lost a pioneering stalwart with the sudden demise of Dato' Dr T Sachithanandan (1931-1981) during a cardiac bypass surgery in London. He was only 49.

He established the first public sector intensive care unit in Malaysia in 1968 at Johor Baru General Hospital (JBGH).

He was also involved in establishing the first

postgraduate medical education centre in the country at JBGH in 1969, with two eminent colleagues - physician Dato' Dr Lim Kee Jin and paediatrician Datuk Dr Sam Abraham. He went on to establish another such centre at Ipoh General Hospital (IGH) in 1976.

He was Perak State Anaesthetist in IGH (1972-77). I had the fortune to encounter the exemplary gentleman and teacher in him, as his medical officer in 1977.


PMPS EVENTS: 17 DEC 2022 & MAR 2023
